- 1. Take English, math, science, history, and world language classes; if appropriate, take **honors** and/or **Advanced Placement** classes.
- 2. Continue to pursue your **extracurricular and leadership activities** in depth both in and out of school.
- 3. Get acquainted with the requirements and standards of colleges that interest you through Scoir.
- 4. Begin to check out college websites and email them any questions you may have.
- 5. Meet with representatives of colleges you are interested in when they visit Darlington.
- 6. Take the **PSAT** in October for practice.
- 7. **Make good use of your summer.** Volunteer, get a job, travel, attend a summer program anything that interests you! You will find that these experiences may provide material for your college application essay(s).
- 8. Talk with current college students and their parents about their experiences at their college. They are great resources for you!
- 9. Read for pleasure! This will have an impact on your SAT/ACT scores!
